



HOW CALGARIANS FEEL ABOUT SAFETY



- 95% feel Calgary is a safe place to live
- 99% rank the Calgary Police Service among the top four most important City services – with 99% saying CPS is very or somewhat important
- Many feel that CPS needs more staff to keep up with the growth of the city and rising crime
- 96% want the City to invest more or the same amount in police
- Citizens value investment in solving violent crimes, crime prevention/youth programs and community partnerships
- Future confidence and trust in police depends on having a workforce that reflects the diversity of the community
- Employee morale is at an all-time low, partly because resources are stretched too thin
