Background / Issue

1. It is critical that the CPS have a strategic plan outlining our goals and strategies to address our approach to maximizing traffic safety.
2. A Traffic Safety Plan (TSP) is required as referenced - Alberta Provincial Policing Standards Operations (OP) Policy 2.4
3. OP 2.4 – Policies to improve road safety police services shall develop a minimum three- year traffic services plan which addresses but is not limited to the following:
 - a. Enforcement.
 - b. Education.
 - c. Research and evaluation.
 - d. Communication and awareness.

- e. Engineering and technology.
 - f. Related stakeholders.
 - g. Reviewed annually and updated as necessary.
4. Compliance: Policy and proof.
 5. Interpretation: Proof a copy of the analysis report used to target traffic safety units to trouble spots. Annual and multi-year plans perhaps, traffic engineer plans
 6. For the operation of ATE - Under Section D in the ATE Guidelines Appendix, the above is also required.

Discussion / Analysis

This presentation is an opportunity for the CPC to become familiar with the 2022-2023 TSP its goals, strategies and results. Commission will also have opportunity to ask questions, receive clarification and provide support or comment into future planning for our joint TSP with City of Calgary Mobility.
