



G7 Leaders' Summit Overview

- Canada will host the 2025 G7 Leaders' Summit in Kananaskis, June 15–17, led by the Prime Minister's Office and Global Affairs Canada
- The G7 Leaders' Summit brings together leading economies to discuss global issues
- The City of Calgary is a key partner, supporting Global Affairs Canada and the Province of Alberta





What It Means For Calgary

- Over 70 guests, 2,000 delegates and 1,400 journalists will attend
- 10,000+ hotel bookings across Alberta
- Calgary as a gateway city for international arrivals
- Increased activity near the airport and downtown
- Temporary road closures, detours and periods of heavier traffic




Airport Tunnel Closure June 15-18



FLYING ZONE



This is your reminder that drones are strictly prohibited in and around the following areas due to aviation regulations and temporary Summit-related restrictions:

- Banff National Park Drones are never permitted in Banff. This is a year-round federal regulation to protect wildlife, visitor safety, and airspace integrity.
- Kananaskis Country –In Alberta's provincial parks, the use of any drone, Unmanned Aerial Vehicle (UAV) or Remotely Piloted Aircraft System (RPAS), regardless of size, is prohibited for recreational use.
- YYC Calgary Airport No drone flights allowed:
 - Within 3.5 nautical miles from the centre of the airport
 - Within 1 nautical mile from any heliport

Fines and penalties: Under Canadian Aviation Regulations, unauthorized drone use can result in jail time or fines **up to \$15,000** for putting aircraft and people at risk.

Drones are not toys. They can interfere with aircraft, emergency operations, and security measures. Leave your drone at home.

If you witness drone activity near restricted zones during the G7 Summit:

- In Calgary: Call CPS non-emergency line at 403-266-1234
- In Banff: Report to Parks Canada Dispatch at 1-888-927-3367 or contact your local RCMP detachment
- In Kananaskis: Report to Kananaskis Emergency Services 403-591-7755 or contact your local RCMP detachment

CPS FUNDING & RESOURCING REQUIREMENTS



- Public Safety Canada has approved the proposed CPS budget, with endorsement from the RCMP.
- Covered by federal funds through the Major International Event Security Cost Framework (MIESCF).
- The costs will **only be publicly available after the end of the G7** Summit and will be provided by Public Safety Canada, not the CPS.
- This event is not anticipated to negatively impact the CPS budget.
- Through planning, the CPS has adequate staffing resources to support G7 operations and maintain policing duties to Calgarians.
- The CPS is currently in the process of identifying, securing and finalizing equipment and facility resources required to support G7.
- We are working on a contribution agreement with CPS legal and the City of Calgary's legal and Capital Planning and Business Services teams.
